- Norman Senjem will present information about the Mississippi River-Lake Pepin maximum daily load project, which will establish pollutant load allocations for point and nonpoint sources to bring the Mississippi River and Lake Pepin in conformance with water quality standards for turbidity (river standard) and eutrophication-nutrient enrichment (lake standard). The project will have implications for NPDES permits, wastewater, and stormwater toward the end of this decade. The presentation will include an overview of water quality data relative to these impairments in the Metro and Lake Pepin areas.
- Norman manages this Mississippi River-Lake Pepin Project for the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency.
